PHCC ART GALLERY PRESENTS FARM TEAM PHOTOGRAPHY

Pasco-Hernando Community College's Art Gallery will be exhibiting works from photographer Joseph Gamble. *Farm Team—A Season in the Minors* will feature black and white photographs of the Savannah Sand Gnats baseball team. An opening reception, sponsored by the Student Activities Office, will be held on Thursday, April 14 from 5 to 7 p.m. The exhibit runs from April 14 through May 12.

Gamble photographically documented the pitfalls and triumphs of the Savannah Sand Gnats 2004 season, the 100th anniversary of minor league baseball in Savannah, Georgia. He traveled on the bus and photographed the team through the rituals of daily summer league life. Gamble's visual chronicle honors the hopeful determination of the minor league team and documents their hardships in pursuit of the highest level of sport.
